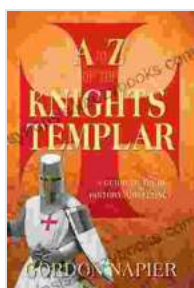


# To the Knights Templar: A Historical Novel

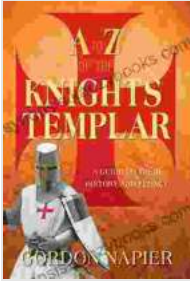

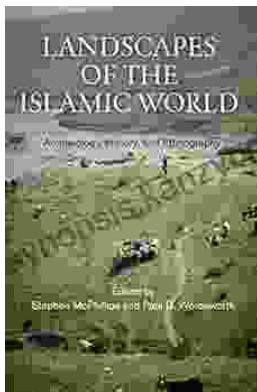

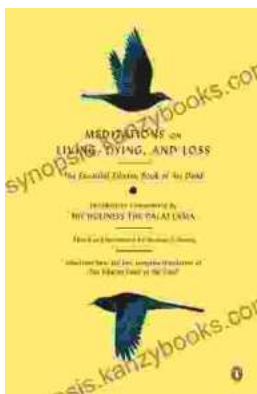
